Per ticket cost for a Tappan Resident is \$60,
Per ticket cost for NON-Tappan residents is \$80

***The 9/11 Museum recommends children be at least 7 years of age to visit the Museum**

The Tappan Library is underwriting a portion of the bus expenses and so we will only extend discounted tickets prices to our Tappan taxpayers.

- ❖ Tickets go on sale Friday, July 27th at 10 am in the library
- ❖ Discounted tickets available to Tappan residents only
 - *Proof of residency will be required at time of purchase*
 - *Limit of 4 tickets per Tappan resident, 2 for non-Tappan resident*
- ❖ Payment required at the time of purchase and must be made in person
 - *We cannot hold tickets for future payment.*
- ❖ We can only accept check or cash, credit cards will not be accepted
- ❖ Each ticket includes:
 - *Round trip bus transportation between Piermont and NYC*
 - *Guided tour of 9/11 Museum*
 - *Admission to One World Observatory*
- ❖ Food will not be provided, but will be available for purchase from surrounding eateries

TRIP DETAILS

- The bus boards at 8:30am and will depart from the parking lot adjacent to the Piermont Library
- Attendees may park in the Piermont Library's parking lot for the duration of the trip
- The Piermont Library is located at 25 Flywheel Park, Piermont, NY 10968
- Each registrant must present their ticket to board the bus
- Library staff members will be checking each attendee in before boarding and collecting tickets
- If you need wheelchair access you must notify the Library at the time of ticket purchase

Please review the museum's visitor rules and regulations regarding security screening, bag size, photography, etc.
Security screenings are mandatory for all visitors and will include screening of all bags, equipment, and belongings.
Bags of any type cannot exceed 8" x 17" x 19" per item.
